

## **120 MESA COUNTY ROAD & BRIDGE STREET SWEEPING POLICY**

### **120 - Street Sweeping for Mesa County**

Mesa County recognizes the need to sweep streets with mechanical street sweepers for a variety of reasons. In urbanized areas, roads will be swept and the material collected will be hauled away. Rural areas may be swept with a mechanical broom sweeping the material onto the road shoulders. Routine sweeping, as typically done within municipalities for the purposes of aesthetics or leaf pickup, is not done. Instead, priorities are followed as listed below:

- ❖ When debris threatens traffic safety, road integrity, and/or drainage
- ❖ Removal of salt/sand after snow storms on major arterial and collector roads
- ❖ Removal of chips after chip sealing activities
- ❖ Cleaning streets deemed necessary by Division forces

All street sweeping activities are limited to the accepted County Road System.
